Motion approved.

Concessions: Clean up for the concession stand will be April $30^{\text {th }}$ from 8 am to 10am. We will use the leftover popcorn and candy for the after prom gift baskets.

Larry Frank: Presented a thank you plaque to the booster club for being a sponsor. Also Larry had a concern that he had not received any money from the Booster Club for working in the concession stand. Amy Schiers had recorded that his organization made $\$ 300.00$ and would make sure Alison Vincent got that information and a check to him.

After Prom: The after prom committee is still looking for volunteers to help out during the evening to help things run smoothly. The inflatables will be dropped off at the recreation center between 1 pm and 3 pm . The casino night tables will be set up by 10 pm . Jesters will give us 20 costumes to use at $\$ 5$ dollars a piece and Becky Champlin will take pictures. There will be turkey bowling and Trent John will DJ with Minute To Win It Games going every half hour. Best Buy will bring 2 TV's with Rock Band and Dance, Dance, Dance to play for the kids. Best Buy also donated a 32 " flat screen TV. The booster club would like to recognize all of the sponsors for after prom with a banner in the school. Lynette Frank volunteered to make a poster to recognize the sponsors to hang up during after prom.
