Spring Grant Request Presentations: \$7920 requested; \$4000 available

*Booster Club cannot sponsor specific students or any travel fees of students.

- English/Library: Requesting \$315 to purchase printing materials for a binding machine, binding tape, binding glue, cardstock, and repair tape. They don't have access to additional funds for these materials. It will impact 150-200 students this Spring semester, but will hopefully last long enough to impact the entire student body in their English classes. They will accept partial funding, and have not received a grant in the past. (Present at meeting.)
- Pizza with professionals: Request for \$500 to purchase pizzas for students who attend monthly meetings where professionals from the community present and speak to students. This is offered by the FHS counseling office and school funds are not allowed to be used to purchase food. They are hoping that the money would roll-over into next year. They received an outside grant that covered the first semester. They will have 3 more meetings this semester, and they average 14 students a meeting. They will accept partial funding and have not received a grant in the past. (Present at meeting.)
- Senior Scholarship Night (May 7th at 6:00pm): Request for \$500 to cater and decorate for the senior scholarship evening for senior students and families to celebrate scholarship winners for Frederick specific scholarships. This is put on by the admin and counseling office. They don't have a budget/funds and reached out to the community for sponsorship and donations as well. Booster club will be included in the program/script for the financial support if grant received. They will accept partial funding and have not received a grant in the past. (Present at meeting.)

- DECA: Request for \$475 to assist students in paying their fees for the registration of their State Competition. They are working to fundraise. They are a new club and need help starting out after several years of non-existence. They will receive partial funding. (Not present at the meeting.)
- Key Club: Requesting \$500 for the registration fee for their State Conference in April. They will be doing other fundraising as well. They received a grant last fall for \$250 and \$500 last spring. There is a fee to join Key Club. They do a lot of community service with the Student Council.
- Cooking Club: Requesting \$800 to purchase ingredients, materials, and supplies. The money hopefully would last them the rest of this year, and into next. There are 54 official members attending the meetings. They will accept partial funding and received a grant in the fall of 2024. (Present at meeting.)
- Girls BBall: Requesting \$1980 to purchase 18 new team basketballs for next season. Basketballs wear quickly and need to be replaced every couple of years. With the rise of expenses for athletics and athletic equipment, their budget will only buy a few. They will accept partial funding and received a grant this fall for \$1100. (Present at meeting.)
- Theater: Requesting \$350 to purchase set supplies and pieces for the spring musical. Students do pay a \$40 fee to participate. They will accept partial funding and have not received a grant in the past. (Unified Theater is a separate club.)
- Wrestling: Requesting \$2000 to purchase warmup gear for the JV and Varsity teams. In the past students have been required to purchase their own. They do fundraising throughout the year. They will accept partial funding, and have received grants in the past, but not within the last two years. (Present at meeting.)
- Baseball: Requesting \$500 to purchase the Pro Velocity Bat training system. This system will stay with the program and will be used at all levels and student athletes. They have participated in fundraising opportunities offered by Booster in the past. They are hoping that it will last for a while so that future classes can benefit from it. They will accept partial funding, and received a grant for \$1500 this fall. (Present at meeting.)
